Creating Jobs: Social Equity & Access to Care in Underserved Communities

UChicago Medicine's proposed \$633 million, 500,000-square-foot cancer center will be the first freestanding cancer facility in Chicago. Pending regulatory approval, construction will begin in 2023. The project is expected to create more than 500 construction jobs.

The 30-acre New Saint Anthony Hospital is projected to add 3,500 jobs in construction, up to 500 jobs in retail, 300+ jobs in education and community programming, and up to 1,100 health care jobs inclusive of the 1,000 current jobs at Saint Anthony Hospital.
